Dual degree Scheme

Students can simultaneously study B.Com with Major in Accountancy and Finance programme offered by IGNOU with Chartered Accountancy First Stage offered by ICAI. This programme comprises of 96 credits, out of which 32 credits are from IGNOU and 64 credits are part of Chartered Accountancy course (First Stage). Articleship training

This training is for period of three years where students get prescribed amount of stipend. For articleship, one needs to be registered for both group of IPCC and passes the first group.

IT (Practical training)-100 hours

One can join in for the IT training before or after IPCC examination but should be before joining articleship training. It is related to subject “Information Technology” (50 marks). ICAI has prescribed fee for registration of ITT.

Library Facility

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FAQs related to CA + Integrated B.Com @ ICA

1. What is the advantage of doing CA + Integrated B.Com @ ICA?

Doing CA + Integrated B.Com @ ICA, you do not need to study or register all the subjects of all the 03 years of the B.Com program. One just needs to register and complete 32 credits subjects i.e. one Academic year of the Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU), B.Com program and remaining 64 credits one can earn from the CA subjects after completion of IPCC level. Hence there is no loss of time and money and no need to simultaneously register and complete all the subjects as it needs to be done for Non IGNOU graduation program.

2. Do we need to appear in any type of entrance exam to get admission in CA under ICAI?

There is no provision of entrance exam for registration in the CA course. One who has appeared 10+2 from any stream with minimum passing criteria can register for the CA course.

3. Is there any specific date or duration to register for the course?

You can register for the course throughout the year. However, one must register few months before the examination.

4. When is the exam conducted by ICAI?

Exams for each level are held twice a year. CPT exams are conducted in the month of June and December. Similarly, IPCC are conducted in the month of May and November.

5. Is CA affiliated to any University?

One is required to register with an autonomous body like ICAN of Nepal and ICAI of India, established under the act of parliament.

6. Is result of 10+2 required for admission in the CA?

Students who have appeared the exam of 10+2 but are waiting for the result can do admission on provisional basis. However, they need to submit the proof of passing 10+2 within the prescribed period to the board (ICAI).

7. Can one study CA along with graduation/ post graduation course?

One can study graduation/ post graduation course along with CA from concerned University.

8. How many hours of study is required in a day?

Though there is no time bound limitation for study of the course, rigorous study in regular manner is required. One of the important aspects for CA students is time management.

9. How long is the course of CA?

One can become Chartered accountant approximately in 4.5 years from ICAI board if he/she passes all the examination in first attempt.

10. How long is the validity of the course?

Once registered for CPT, it is valid for 3 years and 4 years for IPCC; and before the expiry one can re-register for the course for further three years by paying necessary fees to ICAI. Similarly, as for final there is no time deadline.

11. Can PhD be pursued after completing CA?

PhD can be pursued after completing CA course. PhD can be done in accordance to recognition given by concerned university.

12. Do +2 college topper students get any scholarship for CA + Integrated B.Com at ICAI?

There exists a special discount for college toppers of +2. Student needs to submit recommendation letter issued by concerned +2 colleges.

13. Does the college conduct any form of internal class test?

Class tests are generally of two types. One is chapter wise test which are held on weekly basis after completion of each chapter. Other is the internal test which is held thrice within the stated course duration.

14. What are the documents required for admission?

Following are the required documents-

- Mark sheet and character certificate of SLC -3 copies
- Transcript and character certificate of 10+2 -3 copies

- Grade 11 mark sheet and grade 12 admit card (for admission on provisional basis) -3 copies
- Citizenship certificate -3 copies
- PP size photograph -4 copies
